

The GPI US Fellowship is a sought-after one-year fellowship program that is offered on a highly selective basis. Participants are leaders on campus who spread the GPI US mission to fellow students, professors, and the local community. Fellows receive guaranteed acceptance to the Summer 2025 Global Studies Program (GSP; dependent on global health conditions).

### General Responsibilities

- Attend remote meetings with all GPI US Fellows (approximately monthly)

- Advertise for part-time positions

  - Research accommodations, activities, catering, classrooms, and transportation
  - Utilize local community resources to suggest guest speakers and activities
  - Create program itinerary with guidance from GPI US Staff
